Key Understanding: "Palms in their hands" and Revelation 19. Since there are obvious similarities between the 'great multitude' passage of Revelation 7:9-17 and the 'great multitude' passage of Revelation 19:1-10 (especially when the passage of Revelation 7:9-17 is appropriately linked with the 'after the 144,000' and 'Babylon is fallen' passage of Revelation 14:6-13), it would seem as though a characteristic of the Great Multitude of Revelation 19 would be that they also have "palms in their hands," this being in conjunction with their rejoicing over the judgment of the Great Whore, Babylon the Great.

Revelation 7:9 (KJV) After this I beheld, and, lo, <u>A GREAT MULTITUDE</u>, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and <u>PALMS IN THEIR HANDS</u>;

Revelation 19:1-6 (KJV) And after these things I heard A GREAT VOICE OF MUCH PEOPLE IN HEAVEN, saying, Alleluia; Salvation, and glory, and honour, and power, unto the Lord our God: 2 For true and righteous are his judgments: FOR HE HATH JUDGED THE GREAT WHORE, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and hath avenged the blood of his servants at her hand. 3 And again they said, Alleluia.
