

Revelation 19:1-10 (KJV) And after these things I heard <u>A GREAT VOICE OF MUCH</u> **PEOPLE IN HEAVEN**, saying, Alleluia;

Salvation, and glory, and honour, and power, unto the Lord our God:

2 For true and righteous are his judgments: <u>FOR</u> <u>HE HATH JUDGED THE GREAT WHORE</u>
