
Key Understanding: 86'd. Though the origins in American slang of the number 86 coming to mean "to get rid of" are unknown, the truth is that the Lord ordained 86 to have such a meaning to point to the theme of casting out that is associated with Hagar and Ishmael, who was born when Abram was 86 years old. Essentially, the Lord means for the number 86 to be associated with judgment.
