This and the next two Unsealings share identical Key Understandings. However, each Unsealing then goes on to expand upon different aspects of the topic.

Key Understanding #1: Bringing democracy to the Arab nations. Ishmael is considered to be the ancestor of the Arab people according to the traditions of both the Jews and the Muslims. Thus, the bigger picture of why the Lord ordained the 86 years between the April 6 [= 9], 1917, U.S. entry into World War I and the April 9, 2003, fall of Baghdad is that the U.S./Babylon the Great war against Iraq/pretender Babylon the Great represented the U.S. further attempting to build a worldwide Babel by bringing democracy to the Arab nations — the 'seed of Ishmael' nations — through a defeat of Saddam Hussein-led Iraq/pretender Babylon the Great, which occurred 86 'seed of Ishmael' years after the U.S. entry into World War I.

Key Understanding #2: *Iraq* is predominantly Arab, is one of the 22 nations in the modern day Arab League, and is therefore easily tied to the theme of <u>86</u> that is connected with the <u>seed of Ishmael</u>.




