

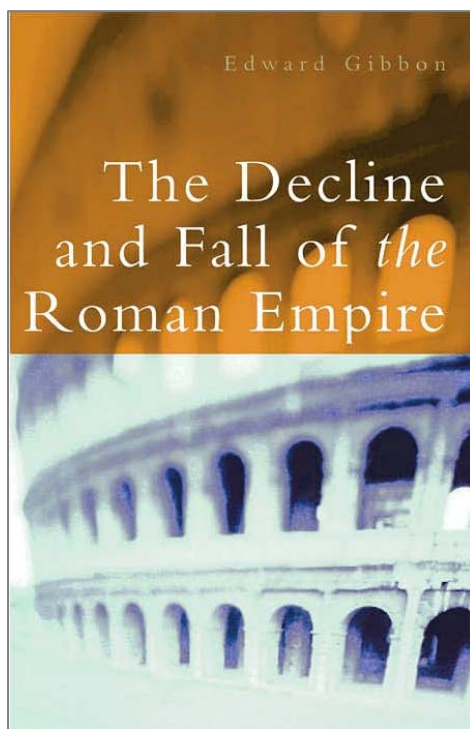

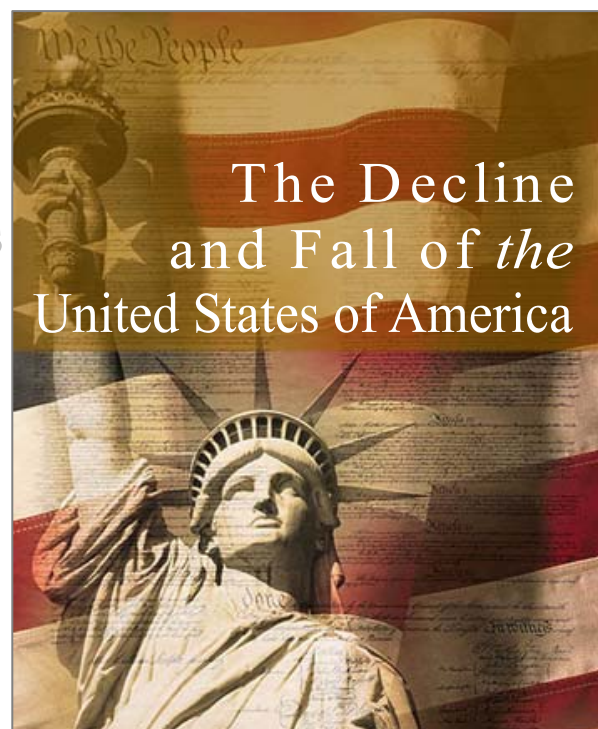
The Decline and Fall of the Roman Empire. *The History of the Decline and Fall of the Roman Empire*, sometimes shortened to *The Decline and Fall of the Roman Empire*, was a major literary achievement of the Eighteenth Century, written by English historian Edward Gibbon. Volume I was published in 1776, and included several printings. A total of six volumes were published through 1788.

The volumes cover the time period of the Roman Empire after Marcus Aurelius from just before 180 A.D. to 1453 A.D. (the fall of Constantinople) and beyond, concluding in 1590. They take as their material the behavior and decisions that led to the decay and eventual fall of the Roman Empire in the East and West, offering an explanation of why the Roman Empire fell.

Key Understanding: *The 2nd edition of the decline and fall of the Roman Empire.* What we shall call the ‘1st edition’ of *The History of the Decline and Fall of the Roman Empire*, referring to the book written by Edward Gibbon about the decline and fall of the original Western and Eastern Roman Empires, *points to* a ‘2nd edition’ of the decline and fall of the Roman Empire, referring to the decline and fall of the United States of America.
