#2823 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a second Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 1082, Jackson Wild Ass Men, (viii), Andrew Jackson represents six (6), and man being born like a wild ass's colt

**Review** (from Unsealings #22 and #2822): 1824 election: the man who became the 7<sup>th</sup> president should have been the 6<sup>th</sup> president. Andrew Jackson, the 7<sup>th</sup> U.S. President, should have actually been the 6<sup>th</sup> U.S. President. The Lord ordained Jackson to be the 7<sup>th</sup> U.S. President, but actually receive more of the popular and initial electoral vote in the Election of 1824 than the man who would become the 6<sup>th</sup> U.S. President, John Quincy Adams, to illustrate the theme that what is pretending to be of God, Seven (7), is actually of Man, Six (6). This is identical to the theme of the Church of Laodicea being numbered Seven (7), as if it was of God, when actually it is of Man, Six (6).

Key Understanding: <u>Jack</u> and <u>son</u>. A male donkey is called a <u>jack</u>, or a jackass. Thus, a wild male ass is a jack, or jackass. In addition, a colt is a <u>son</u>, applied to a young horse, or donkey, or zebra. Thus, in the name <u>Jackson</u> can be seen a jack son, or, more specifically, according to the Lord's plan, a wild ass's colt. Simply, Andrew Jackson is meant to be seen in Job 11:12, and thus is very closely tied to the themes of man and the number six (6).



Job 11:12 (KJV) For vain man would be wise, <u>THOUGH MAN BE BORN LIKE</u> <u>A WILD ASS'S</u> [Jack's] <u>COLT</u> [son].

Genesis 1:27 (KJV) <u>SO GOD CREATED MAN</u> in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.

Genesis 1:31 (KJV) And God saw every thing that he had made, and, behold, it was very good. And the evening and the morning were <u>THE SIXTH DAY</u>.
