

Key Understanding #1: The *naming* of the Republican Party occurred on July 6, 1854, in Jackson, Michigan, a city founded in 1829 and *named* after Andrew Jackson, "founder" of the Democratic Party.

The Republican Party and Jackson, Michigan. The Republican Party was birthed in the early 1850's by anti-slavery activists and individuals who believed that government should grant

western lands to settlers free of charge. The party's first informal meeting took place in Ripon, Wisconsin, a small town northwest of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. The first official Republican meeting occurred on July 6, 1854, in Jackson, Michigan, with David S. Walbridge serving as chairman. At this meeting, the name "Republican" was chosen because it alluded to equality and reminded individuals of Thomas Jefferson's Democratic-Republican Party. At the Jackson convention, the new party adopted a platform and nominated candidates for office in Michigan.

In 1856, the Republicans became a national party when John C. Fremont was nominated

for President of the United States under the slogan: "Free soil, free labor, free speech, free men, Fremont." Even though the Republicans were considered a "third party" because the Democrats and Whigs represented the two-party system at the time, Fremont received 33% of the vote. Four years later, Abraham Lincoln became the first Republican to win the White House.
